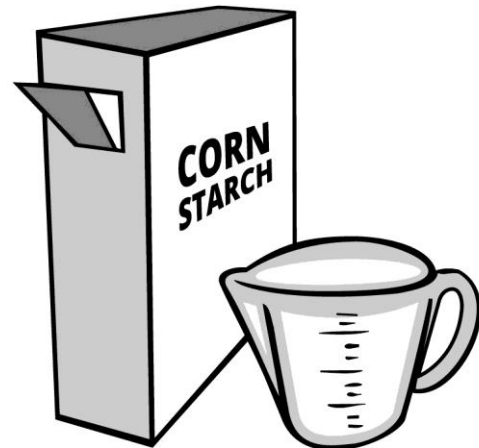

Family Together Time

Try a fun experiment to remember that Jesus is God's Son.

- Put about ½ cup of cornstarch in a large bowl.
- Pour in up to ¼ cup of water, a little bit at a time.
- Reach in and feel the solid clump under the water.
- Pick the solid clump out. When you pull it out of the water, does it stay solid?
- Talk about how the mixture could be both a solid and a liquid.
- Talk about how Jesus can be both human and God's Son.
